2. Minutes
  - a. Approved Minutes from 3/10/16
  - b. Will hold on approving minutes from meeting with Kurt Clay until there are more members in attendance, minutes will be resent to committee members prior to our next meeting
3. Teachers Report (Jenica is out sick today)
  - a. Donna Long did a recorder lesson with 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade
  - b. Students are showing a lot of growth (recorder, Spanish, comoradarie)
  - c. Pat-student dynamics exhibit a tension that students are working on controlling “conflict is not as important as the task they are doing”
  - d. Sue Everest is doing a good job as a substitute
  - e. Lauren is considering planning an end of year campout (pleasure park area and archeological dig or other location)
4. Principal's Report
  - a. Budget Update on all 3 accounts
    - i. TLC anticipated balance is \$396 after shelter building, eurythmy, dance, brochures.
    - ii. Discussed fundraising for 16-17 to address enrichment classes, goal would be \$6,700 to cover one enrichment class per quarter plus handwork and eurythmy
    - iii. Want to establish a set rate of pay for enrichment classes, proposol is \$20.00
    - iv. Parents that are providing enrichment class instruction are stongly encouraged to donate their time and talents for enrichment classes.
    - v. We cannot commit any additional TLC funds for this year if we want to have some money available to set up summer fundraising opporunitites.
    - vi. We have spent approximately \$1,700 on marketing for this year.

  - c. Enrollment – currently projecting 32
  - d. Activities – Talent show, visitor's morning, spring vacation, CMAS testing, parent night, kindergarten registration, community council meeting, open house
