3rd-6th grade Colorado State Testing

Our annual state student assessments begin in April. This year Colorado students will be taking PARCC (3rd-5th grade Language Arts and Math) and CMAS (5th grade Science) tests. Each scheduled day of testing will include one online testing session of approximately 60 minutes. NFSIS students will not be testing online, they will be taking a paper/pencil test.
